

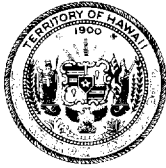

Beginning at the southwest corner of this lot, the northwest corner of L.C. Aw. 6666 to Maalo and on the east side of a 30 foot roadway, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Transit of Venus" being 462.43 feet North and 751.49 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2596, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:

1. 149° 22' 58.79 feet along the east side of a 30 foot roadway;
2. 206° 30' 29.36 feet to the south boundary of land deeded by Kamehameha IV to G.B. Rowell on November 30, 1857, and recorded in Liber 10, on page 137;
3. 257° 05' 98.21 feet along land deeded by Kamehameha IV to G.B. Rowell, on November 30, 1857, and recorded in Liber 10, on page 137;
4. 328° 29' 34.00 feet along L.C. Aw. 6568 Apana 2 to E. Pule;
5. 34° 47' 88.60 feet along Lot 74, Waimea Government Remnants;
6. 93° 40' 46.20 feet along L.C. Aw. 6666 to Maalo to the point of beginning.
