Lot 15.

Hakalau Homesteads,
S. Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 14 and on the South side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 19560.4 feet North and 9343.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 326° 55' 200.0 feet along Lot 14 to stream;
2. 54° 00' 330.0 feet along stream;
3. 31° 03' 453.0 feet along stream to a post at North corner of Grant 1043 to Kapou and Samuela.
4. 52° 25' 414.5 feet along Grant 1043 to Kapou Samuela to a post;
5. 146° 38' 526.0 feet across stream and along Lot 16 to an iron rail on the South side of 40 foot road;
6. 240° 20' 526.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron rail;
7. 241° 15' 630.0 feet along 40 foot road to the point of beginning.

Area 9-74/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet for the flume across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 12/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 9-62/100 ACRES. Also Excepting and reserving the stream and all riparian and other rights in or to this stream and the waters thereof.
