Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North boundary of this lot, the West corner of Lot 14 and on the East side of Weloka Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 7186.7 feet South and 4409.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 311° 15' 1110.9 feet along Lot 14 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe
2. 53° 24' 442.0 feet along land of Maulua Nui to "Trig. Station" cement post marked by 2½ inch galv. iron pipe;
3. 99° 34' 1085.0 feet along Grant 4285 to J. C. Cook, to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 233° 45' 122.1 feet along top of East edge of Kapehu gulch;
5. 207° 31' 153.4 feet along top of East edge of Kapehu gulch;
6. 199° 29' 262.8 feet along top of East edge of Kapehu gulch;
7. 230° 38' 110.4 feet along top of East edge of Kapehu gulch;
8. 212° 55' 206.2 feet along top of East edge of Kapehu gulch;
9. 220° 17' 164.7 feet along top of East edge of Kapehu gulch;
11. 192° 46' 13.9 feet along top of East edge of Kapehu gulch;
11. 311° 15' 34.1 feet across Weloka Road to the point of beginning.
