Original Plan

Beginning at the West corner of Grant 1532, Kamalii, at + on stone 18 feet makai of old stone wall at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 8220.1 feet S. and 16769.5 feet E. and from which Lolena-nui Trig. Station bears N 64° 4' 30" E true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu:-

1. N 42° 44' W 1357 feet along Lot 16A and 16B;
2. S 52° 7' W 677 feet along Government reservation for 40 foot road;
3. S 35° 27' E 1912 feet along Lot 18;
4. N 63° 57' E 841 feet along Lot 14;
5. N 34° 10' W 735 feet along Grant 1532 to the initial point and containing an area of 36 Acres.
