KAUPAKUEA HOMESTEADS,
South Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, and the East corner of two 30 foot Homestead Roads, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 1745.0 feet North and 7403.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2546, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 249° 37' 1325.0 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road to a pipe;
2. 341° 30' 430.8 feet along Grant 872 to Emma Metcalf to a pipe in the middle of gulch;
3. Thence along middle of gulch to a pipe on East side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the direct azimuth and distance being, 80° 45' 1459.5 feet;
4. 198° 46' 191.9 feet along road to the point of beginning.
