Beginning at a pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot at the intersection of the homestead roads, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2055.2 feet North and 67.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 94° 16' 325.3 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
2. 90° 07' 906.3 feet along North side of homestead road to a post;
3. 169° 48' 256.0 feet along Lot 17 to a galvanized spike in pahoehoe 10 feet from the edge of the stream;
4. Easterly along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a + on pahoehoe, the direct azimuth and distance being: 248° 14' 1140.4 feet;
5. 340° 30' 96.5 feet to a post;
6. 305° 59' 158.5 feet to a post;  
along West side of homestead road
7. 353° 44' 519.8 feet to the point of beginning.
