Beginning at a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 17, and on the East side of Kapehu Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 6796.9 feet South and 3055.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $311^{\circ} 15'$  1164.5 feet along Lot 17 to a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe;
2.  $18^{\circ} 59'$  96.0 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
3.  $33^{\circ} 20'$  158.4 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
4.  $60^{\circ} 51'$  198.1 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
5.  $12^{\circ} 04'$  63.0 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
6.  $116^{\circ} 58'$  1225.0 feet along Grant 4283 to J.S.Low to a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe;
7.  $221^{\circ} 15'$  789.5 feet along East side of Kapehu Road to the point of beginning.
