Beginning at a mamane post at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 15 on the East side of the Polipoli road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being: 11027.3 feet South and 13930.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:—

1. 309° 46' 1358.0 feet along Lot 15 to a mamane post on the boundary of the mauka pasture lands;
2. 39° 46' 700.0 feet along the mauka pasture lands to a mamane post;
3. 129° 46' 1322.0 feet along Lot 17 to a mamane post on the East side of the Polipoli road;
4. 220° 15' 205.0 feet along the Polipoli road to a mamane post;
5. 238° 43' 190.0 feet along the Polipoli road to a mamane post;
6. 187° 00' 229.8 feet along the Polipoli road to a mamane post;
7. 231° 11' 125.0 feet along the Polipoli road to the point of beginning.
