Beginning at the West corner of Grant 1532 to Kamalii at a + on stone 18 feet makai of old stone wall at a point whose coordinates referred to "Akihi" Trig. Station are 8220.1 feet South and 16769.5 feet East and from which "Lolena-nui" Trig. Station is by true azimuth $244^{\circ} 04' 30''$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $137^{\circ} 16'$ 822.0 feet along ~~18 feet right of way in~~ Lot 15 to + on stone in wall;
2. $222^{\circ} 55'$ 984.0 feet along Lot 16B to + on stone in wall;
3. $302^{\circ} 55'$ 885.0 feet along Lot 1 to + on stone on side hill 15 feet East of stone wall;
4. $52^{\circ} 47'$ 1008.0 feet along Lot 1 and Grant 1532 to Kamalii to + on stone;
5. $11^{\circ} 19'$ 240.0 feet along Grant 1532 to Kamalii to the point of beginning.
