Beginning at a + on stone ⁱⁿ wall at the South corner of this lot, and the West corner of Lot 16A, the true azimuth and distance to + on stone at the South corner of Lot 16A being $317^{\circ} 16'$ 822.0 feet, and from said + on stone at the South corner of Lot 16A the true azimuth to "Lolena-nui" Trig. Station is $244^{\circ} 04' 30''$ and the coordinates referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akihi" are 8220.1 feet South, and 16769.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $137^{\circ} 16'$ 576.0 feet along ^{12 Foot Right-of-Way} Lot 15 and crossing 40 foot road reserve to + on stone;
2. $139^{\circ} 23'$ 510.0 feet along Lot 17 to + on stone;
3. $227^{\circ} 50'$ 750.0 feet along Lot 2 to + on stone on side of pali;
4. $308^{\circ} 40'$ 415.0 feet along Lot 1 to + on stone at base of pali;
5. $302^{\circ} 55'$ 617.0 feet along Lot 1 and crossing 40 foot road reserve to + on stone in wall;
6. $42^{\circ} 55'$ 984.0 feet along Lot 16A to the point of beginning.

Area 20.8 acres

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide for the road which crosses this lot, Area $9/10$ Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF $19-9/10$ ACRES.
