Beginning at a pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 18 and on the North side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 1649.8 feet North and 2101.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 168° 37' 1121.7 feet along Lot 18 to a post 10 feet from the edge of ~~the~~ stream;
2. Southeasterly along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of ~~the~~ stream to a spike on pahoehoe, the direct azimuth and distance being:  
293° 00' 1065.4 feet;
3. 349° 48' 256.0 feet along Lot 16 to a post on North side of homesteads road;
4. 90° 07' 265.0 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
5. 51° 20' 691.3 feet along North side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
