Beginning at a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 18 and on the South side of a 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Alala" being 2183.0 feet South and 4919.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2497, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 360° 00' 756.0 feet along Lot 18 to the top of the pali near the edge of the Waiaama Gulch;
2. Thence Northwesterly along the top of the pali near the edge of the Waiaama Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being 116° 19' 728.4 feet;
3. 215° 34' 169.5 feet along the Government Road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 200° 44' 124.8 feet along the Government Road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 177° 54' 107.0 feet along the Government Road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 260° 05' 436.1 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. 273° 05' 85.0 feet along road to the point of beginning.

Area 2-07/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom rights-of-way 15 feet wide for the flume across this lot.
