Beginning at a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South side of Lepoloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina ^(Old)" being 4384.0 feet South and 1792.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2588, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 60° 30' 2179.2 feet along the land of Umauma to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 142° 20' 83.1 feet along ditch to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 227° 17' 1735.3 feet along Lot 7 Opea-Peleau Homesteads to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 236° 12' 502.9 feet along Lot 7 Opea-Peleau Homesteads to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 330° 30' 516.9 feet along Lot 16 crossing Lepoloa Road to the point of beginning.
