Beginning at a post at the East corner of this lot at a point on the makai edge of the ditch adjoining the road reserve, the coordinates of which point are 6476.2 feet South and 8044.9 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2381, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 45° 25' 330.3 feet along road reserve;
2. 27° 59' 126.0 feet along road reserve;
3. 60° 40' 103.5 feet along road reserve;
4. 41° 59' 189.6 feet along road reserve;
5. 80° 06' 441.6 feet along road reserve to a post;
6. 153° 50' 1605.0 feet along Lot 18 to a boulder marked Δ in center of Honohina Stream;
7. Down center of Honohina Stream along lands of Honohina to a stone marked Δ under the flume, the direct azimuth and distance being: 250° 12' 1182.0 feet;
8. Along the makai edge of the ditch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 290° 00' 457.0 feet;
9. Continuing along the makai edge of the ditch, the direct azimuth and distance being 354° 00' 1080.0 feet to the point of beginning.
