Beginning at a 2" galvanized iron pipe on the South side of this lot and on the west side of a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Haiku" being 3042.9 feet South and 388.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map NO. 2568 and running by true azimuths:-

1. 35° 56' 192.7 feet along lot 15/16 to a pipe;
2. 44° 24' 171.6 feet along Lot 15/16 to a pipe;
3. 68° 34' 623.0 feet along lot 15/16 to a pipe;
4. 135° 39' 137.7 feet along lot 15/16 to a pipe at the top of the South edge of Waikaumalo Gulch;
5. Thence along the top of the South edge of Waikaumalo Gulch to a pipe on the West side of lot 20/22, the direct azimuth and distance being: 218° 03' 1726.7 feet;
6. 315° 33' 472.7 feet along lot 20/22 to a pipe at the EAST corner of this lot;
7. 34° 59' 452.9 feet along lot 18/19 to a pipe;
8. 42° 57' 500.5 feet along Lot 18/19 to a pipe on the East side of a 30 foot road;
9. 42° 57' 32.0 feet ^{across} along end of 30 foot road to the point of beginning.
