Beginning at a W on set stone at the West corner of this lot and North corner of Lot 18 and on the East side of Government Road, the true azimuth and distance from said point of beginning to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Koha" being $143^{\circ} 22'$ 5449.4 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2391, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $259^{\circ} 31'$ 178.0 feet along South side of road to + on set stone;
2. $275^{\circ} 31'$ 805.0 feet along South side of road to + on set stone;
3. $227^{\circ} 10'$ 325.0 feet along South side of road to + on set stone;
4. Thence along the East side of the Government Road on a compound curve to the left and right, the direct azimuth and distance being $191^{\circ} 10'$ 219.0 feet to a + on set stone;
5. $277^{\circ} 32'$ 880.0 feet along South side of road to + on set stone;
6. $336^{\circ} 55'$ 175.0 feet along West side of road to + on set stone;
7. $00^{\circ} 31'$ 472.5 feet along West side of road to + on set stone;
8. $46^{\circ} 39'$ 1385.0 feet along Lot 16 to + on set stone;
9. $137^{\circ} 54'$ 1765.0 feet along Lot 18 to the point of beginning.
