Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 16, from which point the true azimuth and distance is $110^{\circ} 52'$ 5232.0 feet to the "Concrete Post" which marks the Southwest corner of Lot 12 and also the Southwest corner of this tract, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $201^{\circ} 23'$ 3792.0 feet along Lot 16 to the South side of the Government Road;
2. $315^{\circ} 00'$ 148.0 feet along South side of Government Road;
3. $309^{\circ} 03'$ 262.0 feet along South side of Government Road;
4. $32^{\circ} 40'$ 194.0 feet along South side of Government Road;
5. $291^{\circ} 00'$ 88.0 feet along South side of Government Road;
6. $32^{\circ} 36'$ 262.0 feet along South side of Government Road;
7. $349^{\circ} 11'$ 203.0 feet along South side of Government Road;
8. $32^{\circ} 42'$ 366.0 feet along South side of Government Road;
9. $321^{\circ} 36'$ 150.0 feet along South side of Government Road;
10. $263^{\circ} 07'$ 183.0 feet along South side of Government Road to the Northwest corner of Lot 17A;
11. $22^{\circ} 01'$ 2681.0 feet along Lot 17A to the Southeast corner of this lot;
12. $110^{\circ} 52'$ 682.0 feet along Government land to the point of beginning.


