~~Lot 1:~~ Beginning at a concrete post at the Northwest corner of L.C.A. 4853 L, Ap. 3 to Kaopa, adjoining L.C.A. 4665 G, Ap. 4 to Ehu, the coordinates from Government Survey Trig. Station "Keanae" being: North 586.4 feet and East 1189.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2238, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $355^{\circ} 30'$ 150.0 feet along L.C.A. 4853 L, Ap. 3 to Kaopa, and Government land to edge of Kukuipuka Gulch;
