1. 16° 01' 122.7 feet along road reserve;
2. 68° 14' 138.9 feet along road reserve;
3. 88° 07' 229.7 feet along road reserve;
4. 76° 05' 227.9 feet along road reserve;
5. 2° 01' 193.4 feet along road reserve;
6. 52° 32' 203.9 feet along road reserve;
7. 58° 51' 168.7 feet along road reserve;
8. 153° 40' 2017.0 feet along Lot 19 to a boulder marked XVIII in the Honohina Stream;
9. Along the Honohina Stream to boulder marked  $\Delta$ , the direct azimuth and distance being: 256° 23' 1145.3 feet;
10. 333° 50' 1605.0 feet along Lot 17 to the point of beginning.
