Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 19, and the West side of Kapehu Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 6899.5 feet South and 2926.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 41° 15' 634.4 feet along West side of Kapehu Homestead Road;
2. 116° 58' 912.8 feet along Grant 4332 to A. Cockburn;
3. 208° 03' 94.4 feet along top of East edge of Kaalau gulch;
4. 196° 44' 228.7 feet along top of East edge of Kaalau gulch;
5. 234° 23' 179.0 feet along top of East edge of Kaalau gulch;
6. 200° 30' 110.6 feet along top of East edge of Kaalau gulch;
7. 243° 44' 305.2 feet along top of East edge of Kaalau gulch;
8. 311° 15' 882.9 feet along Lot 19 to the point of beginning.
