Beginning at a + on stone at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Grant 1238 to Pupuka and the Southwest corner of Grant 1249 to Kaawapahulu, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Burns" is $312^{\circ} 41'$ 1148.7 feet and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pimoe" are 5441.9 feet North and 1146.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2500, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $69^{\circ} 57'$ 682.3 feet along Lot 19 to a + on stone on the East side of homestead road;
2. Northwesterly along the East side of homestead road, to a + on stone the direct azimuth and distance being: $164^{\circ} 40'$ 668.5 feet to a + on stone;
3. $243^{\circ} 40'$ 191.5 feet along Grant 4897:1 to D. Pali to a + on stone;
4. $307^{\circ} 30'$ 814.8 feet along Grant 1238 to Pupuka to the point of beginning.
