Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch iron pipe at West corner of this lot, on the Northeast side of Middle Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 4483.3 feet North and 157.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $203^{\circ} 33'$  1190.0 feet along Government Reserve to a pipe;
2.  $293^{\circ} 33'$  650.0 feet along Lot 20;
3.  $23^{\circ} 33'$  1190.0 feet along Lot 19;
4.  $113^{\circ} 33'$  650.0 feet along Middle Road to the point of beginning.
