

Beginning at an iron pipe at the East corner of this lot and on the North side of Homestead Road (40 feet wide), the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being: 10517.3 feet North and 344.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2382, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 68° 19' 259.5 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
2. 106° 05' 114.1 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
3. 92° 24' 193.5 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
4. 85° 44' 247.3 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a Pipe;
5. 101° 12' 300.0 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
6. 148° 00' 1620.0 feet along Lot 20 to a post on the South bank of Kaahakini Gulch;
7. Thence down the middle of Kaahakini Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance to a post on the South bank of said gulch at the West corner of Lot 18 being: 189° 17' 510.0 feet;
8. 315° 00' 2632.0 feet along Lot 18 to the point of beginning.
