Beginning at a pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 20 and on the North side of homesteads road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 1724.0 feet North and 3448.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 168° 57' 677.7 feet along Lot 20 and across a stream to a post 10 feet from edge of stream;
2. Easterly along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being: 248° 02' 523.9 feet;
3. 4° 47' 57.2 feet to a post on West side of homestead road;
4. 273° 06' 227.8 feet along Southside of homestead road to a post;
5. 342° 21' 153.1 feet along West side of homestead road to a post;
6. 35° 25' 93.7 feet along West side of homestead road to a post;
7. 301° 38' 130.6 feet along West side of homestead road to a post;
8. 347° 59' 509.1 feet along West side of homestead road to a post on the North side of homestead road;
9. 91° 18' 30" 413.9 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
10. 88° 05' 30" 374.5 feet along North side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
