Beginning at a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 20 and on the South side of a 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Alala" being 2461.3 feet South and 5950.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2497, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 90° 00' 60.0 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 117° 05' 330.1 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. Southwesterly on a curve to the right parallel to and 30 feet East of the center line of the Hilo Railroad Co.'s right-of-way, radius of 1462.7 feet, the direct azimuth and distance to point of tangency being 18° 46' 201.0 feet;
4. 22° 24' 780.0 feet parallel to and 30 feet West of the center line of the Hilo Railroad Co.'s right-of-way to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. Thence Southeasterly along the top of the pali near the edge of the Waiaama Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being 292° 13' 773.2 feet;
6. 180° 00' 1053.4 feet along Lot 20 to the point of beginning.

Area 14 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 15 feet wide across this lot for the flume.
