Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 18, the West side of Kapehu Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 6899.5 feet South and 2926.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 131° 15' 882.9 feet along Lot 18 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 198° 39' 189.3 feet along top edge of Kaalau gulch;
3. 242° 55' 163.3 feet along top edge of Kaalau gulch;
4. 224° 57' 256.1 feet along top edge of Kaalau gulch;
5. 218° 09' 118.1 feet along top edge of Kaalau gulch;
6. 175° 44' 68.1 feet along top edge of Kaalau gulch;
7. 311° 15' 934.1 feet along South side of Kapehu Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
8. 41° 15' 748.0 feet along West side of Kapehu Road to the point of beginning.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom the Government Survey Trig. Station "Kapehu B" within this lot, with the right to enter upon said lot to occupy said Trig. Station.
