Beginning at a + on stone on the North side of the Government Road and on the boundary of Kalaheo, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Kekaunahoa" is  $204^{\circ} 05'$  293.1 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaluamoa" are 6760.5 feet South and 3489.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2493, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $204^{\circ} 05'$  293.1 feet along the land of Kalaheo to Trig. Station "Kekaunahoa";
2.  $253^{\circ} 04' 30''$  319.6 feet along the land of the Kauai Land & Fruit Company to a pipe on the North side of the Government road;
3.  $358^{\circ} 50'$  430.6 feet along West side of Government road to a + on stone;
4.  $29^{\circ} 51'$  32.6 feet along Government road to a + on stone;
5.  $64^{\circ} 15'$  41.8 feet along Government road to a + on stone;
6.  $103^{\circ} 25'$  233.6 feet along Government road to a + on stone;
7.  $111^{\circ} 57'$  165.4 feet along Government road to the point of beginning.
