KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

KAU, HAWAII.

Lot 19.

Beginning at the South corner of Lot 18 at + on stone and ahu at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 9563.5 feet S. and 15675.1 feet E. and from which Lolena-nui Trig. Station bears N 51° 49' E true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all point being marked by + on stone and ahu;

1. N 63° 57' E 840 feet along Lot 18;
2. S 25° 23' E 1970 feet along Lot 14 and crossing Government road to a point 8-1/2 feet mauka of stone wall;
3. S 76° 8' W 888 feet along Grant 2787, W.C. Shipman, Lot 2, to a point 5 feet mauka of stone wall;
4. N 24° 22' W 1790 feet along Lot 20 and crossing Government road to the initial point and containing an area of 35-4/10 Acres; exclusive of a Government reservation, 60 feet wide, through which the Government road passes.
