Beginning at a + on stone at the West corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 18 and on the North side of Kuamoo Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" being 1731.8 feet South and 9782.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2601, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 199° 35' 1706.2 feet along Lot 18 passing over a pipe at 1568.8 feet, to the middle of Opaekaa Stream;

Thence down the middle of ^{Opaekaa}~~Opaekaa~~ Stream, in all its windings, the direct azimuths and distances being:

2. 260° 11' 931.6 feet;
3. 28° 36' 258.4 feet;
4. 354° 03' 499.1 feet;
5. 331° 18' 227.3 feet;
6. 19° 35' 744.6 feet along Lot 20 to a + on stone;
7. 83° 40' 1286.6 feet along North side of Kuamoo Road to the point of beginning.

Area 40-41/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving the waters and all riparian and other rights in or to the stream aforesaid and in or to the stream passing over and across said lot.

Also, excepting and reserving therefrom the Government Survey Trig. Station "Hau" and a lot 50 feet square surrounding same, (area 6/100 acre), together with the right to enter upon said lot and to occupy said Trig. Station, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 40-35/100 ACRES.
