Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 194 and on the North side of Kawaihau Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" being 12067.1 feet North and 11370.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2583 and running by true azimuths:-

1. $204^{\circ} 14'$ 640.1 feet along Lot 194 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe, passing over "Mailihuna" Trig. Station at 22.9 feet;
2. $294^{\circ} 14'$ 987.6 feet along Lots 196 and 197 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galv. iron pipe;
3. $24^{\circ} 14'$ 697.7 feet along Lots 199 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galv. iron pipe;
4. $117^{\circ} 34'$ 990.0 feet along Kawaihau Road to the point of beginning.

Area $15-17/100$ Acres.

1. Excepting and reserving therefrom the Government Survey Trig. Station "Mailihuna" within this lot with the right to enter upon said lot to occupy said Trig. Station.

2. Also excepting and reserving the right to the present public road as shown on the plan hereto attached and made a part hereof until such time said public road is abandoned.

3. Also excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way for the ditches across this lot; said right-of-way containing an area of $39/100$ acre; LEAVING A NET AREA OF $14-78/100$ ACRE.
