Beginning at a + on stone at the North corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Grant 1249 to Kaawapahulu, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Burns" is $312^{\circ} 41'$ 1148.7 feet and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pimoe" are 5441.9 feet North and 1146.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2500, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $2^{\circ} 27'$ 1172.0 feet along Lot 20 to a + on stone on the North side of homestead road;
2. Northwesterly along homestead road to a + on stone, the direct azimuth and distance being: $147^{\circ} 46'$ 1108.0 feet;
3. $249^{\circ} 57'$ 682.3 feet along Lot 18 to the point of beginning.
