Beginning at a 1½ inch iron pipe at the West corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 18, Kalopa Homesteads, on the Northeast side of Middle Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 4223.6 feet North and 753.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 203° 33' 1190.0 feet along Lot 18;
2. 293° 33' 587.8 feet along Lot 20 to a pipe;
3. 27° 35' 626.6 feet along Lot 28 to a pipe;
4. 293° 33' 64.0 feet along Lot 28 to a + on rock in the middle of a small gulch;
5. 12° 25' 352.3 feet along Lot 28, along the middle of small gulch to a pipe;
6. 38° 30' 554.5 feet along Lot 28, along the middle of small gulch to a pipe;
7. 130° 01' 46.0 feet along Northeast side of Middle Road to a pipe;
8. 190° 00' 170.0 feet along Northeast side of Middle Road to a pipe;
9. 144° 41' 267.3 feet along Northeast side of Middle Road to a pipe;
10. 113° 33' 220.0 feet along Northeast side of Middle Road to the point of beginning.
