5. $103^{\circ} 47'$ 43.3 feet along Lot 21;
6. $194^{\circ} 33'$ 71.6 feet along Lot 21;
7. $284^{\circ} 34'$ 96.5 feet along Government Land;
8. $283^{\circ} 39'$ 199.8 feet along Lot 19 to the initial point.
