Station "Nonou" being 2052.6 feet South and 7190.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2601, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 112° 50' 1241.0 feet along Northeast side of Kuamoo Road to a + on stone;
2. 83° 40' 170.0 feet along North side of Kuamoo Road to a + on stone;
3. 199° 35' 744.6 feet along Lot 19 to the middle of ~~Opaikea~~<sup>Opakea</sup> Stream;

Thence down the middle of ~~Opaikea~~<sup>Opakea</sup> Stream, in all its windings, the direct azimuths and distances being:
