Beginning at 3/4 inch iron pipe and ahu at the East corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 20 and on the West side of West Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamakamaka" being: 3727.8 feet North and 8110.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2441, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 73° 27' 1263.9 feet along Lot 20 to center of flume;
2. 158° 37' 30" 473.4 feet along center of flume;
3. 249° 55' 30" 1090.3 feet along Lot 22 to an angle iron and ahu;
4. 321° 30' 580.0 feet along West Road to the point of beginning.

Area 12-57/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide along the West side of this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 10/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 12-47/100 ACRES.
