Beginning at a pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 22 and on the North side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 1703.3 feet North and 4733.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 177° 33' 1190.7 feet along Lots 22 <sup>and 23 and</sup> across three streams to a post 10 feet from edge of stream;
2. Easterly along a line parallel to and 10 from the edge of stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being: 268° 44' 540.2 feet;
3. 357° 33' 1201.9 feet along Lot 20 and across two streams to a pipe on the North side of homestead road;
4. 89° 55' 30" 540.7 feet along North side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
