Beginning at a + on stone at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 22 and on the South side of the Government Road, from which the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Paper" is $108^{\circ} 39' 30''$ 1851.4 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalua-moa" are 6508.8 feet South and 276.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2493, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $279^{\circ} 40'$ 300.8 feet along South side of Government road to a + on stone on the boundary of the McBryde Sugar Co. land
2. $15^{\circ} 33' 30''$ 1491.0 feet along the boundary of the land of the McBryde Sugar Co. and across two ditches to a + on stone on the North side of road to Kukuiula;
3. $106^{\circ} 00'$ 300.0 feet along North side of road to Kukuiula to a + on stone;
4. $195^{\circ} 33' 30''$ 1458.6 feet along Lot 22 across two ditches to the point of beginning.

Area 10-14/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom rights-of-way 15 feet wide across this lot for the two ditches, said rights-of-way containing an area of 48/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 9-66/100 ACRES
