Beginning at a + on stone at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 8 and on the North side of Government road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Allen" is $190^{\circ} 52'$ 120.0 feet and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pimoe" are 3450.6 feet North and 262.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2500, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $190^{\circ} 52'$ 1114.7 feet along Lot 8 to a + on stone;
2. $288^{\circ} 50'$ 139.5 feet along Grant 5070 to Goodness to a + on stone
3. $198^{\circ} 50'$ 184.4 feet along Grant 5070 to Goodness to a + on stone on the South side of homestead road;
4. Southeasterly along homestead road to a + on stone, the direct azimuth and distance being $304^{\circ} 41'$ 289.6 feet;
5. $16^{\circ} 25'$ 1150.0 feet along Lot 22 to a + on stone on the North side of the Government road;
6. Westerly along the Government road to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being: $97^{\circ} 59'$ 317.7 feet;
