Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 22, on the West side of Kahawai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 5944.9 feet North and 2402.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $339^{\circ} 40'$  619.6 feet along West side of Kahawai road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $27^{\circ} 00'$  43.5 feet along the West side of Kahawai Road;
3.  $113^{\circ} 33'$  1930.7 feet along Lot 20 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $203^{\circ} 33'$  490.0 feet along the East side of Gravity Railroad right-of-way to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
5.  $293^{\circ} 33'$  1504.0 feet along Lot 22 to the point of beginning.
