Kamaole Homesteads,

Kula, Maui.

Beginning at a point on the West side of the Government Road on the boundary between the lands of Kamaole and Keokea, the true azimuth and distance to  $\dagger$  on stone at the West corner of Lot 20 on said boundary being  $28^{\circ} 03'$  65.0 feet, the coordinates of said  $\dagger$  on stone referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamaole" being 3648.6 feet North and 1796.9 feet West, and the true azimuth and distance from said Trig. Station "Kamaole" to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Kali" is  $264^{\circ} 25'$  21260.6 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2237, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $104^{\circ} 03'$  830.0 feet along land of Keokea to a point 200 feet from the sea shore;
2. Thence parallel to and 200 feet from shore to a point on the Government Road, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $328^{\circ} 27'$  2962.0 feet;
3.  $166^{\circ} 35'$  290.0 feet along Government Road;
4.  $161^{\circ} 40'$  2150.0 feet along Government Road to the point of beginning.
