Waimea Valley Government Remnants

Waimea (Kona), Kauai, T. H.

Being a portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Waimea.

Beginning at the south corner of this lot, the west corner of Grant 8215 to Kahanamui Aka (Lot 21-A of Waimea Valley Government Remnants) and on the northeast boundary of Grant 8054 to Koichi Yamagata (Lot 20 of Waimea Valley Government Remnants), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "TRANSIT OF VENUS" being 1852.00 feet North and 2128.84 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2596, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 123° 56' 113.50 feet along Grant 8054 to Koichi Yamagata (Lot 20 of Waimea Valley Government Remnants) and Lot 21-C of Waimea Valley Government Remnants;
2. 209° 00' 19.50 feet to a pipe;
3. 303° 00' 115.20 feet along Apana 1 of the land conveyed to M. P. Whitney by Kamehameha III by deed dated June 17, 1853 and recorded in Liber 5 Page 959;
4. 33° 56' 21.30 feet along Grant 8215 to Kahanamui Aka (Lot 21-A of Waimea Valley Government Remnants) to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 2328 Square Feet.
