Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 221, and on the East side of Kaehulua Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" being 10242.1 feet North and 6501.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2583, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $176^{\circ} 21'$  237.7 feet along Kaehulua Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
2.  $148^{\circ} 58'$  313.5 feet along Kaehulua Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
3.  $208^{\circ} 44'$  1429.7 feet along Lot 219 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
4.  $329^{\circ} 44'$  543.5 feet along Lot 213 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
5.  $345^{\circ} 52'$  103.3 feet along Lot 223 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
6.  $34^{\circ} 08'$  640.5 feet along Lot 222 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
7.  $34^{\circ} 20'$  799.0 feet along Lot 221 to point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom the stream and all riparian and other rights in or to said stream and the waters thereof.
