Ponahawai and Portion of the Land Conveyed
by the First Trust Co. of Hilo, Limited, to
the Territory of Hawaii by Deed dated Dec.
4, 1923, recorded in Book 708 Page 324, in
the Office of the Registrar of Conveyances
at Honolulu.

Being a Portion of Grant 8360 to The First
Trust. Co. of Hilo, Ltd.

Beginning at an ↗ cut in concrete sidewalk at the
South corner of this lot and at the North corner of Punahoa and
Ponahawai Streets, the coordinates of said point of beginning
referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 2173.45
feet North and 4269.11 feet East, as shown on Government Survey
Registered Map 2478, and running by azimuths measured clockwise
from true South:-

1. 130° 42' 146.89 feet along the North side of Punahoa Street
to a pipe;
2. 216° 43' 101.41 feet along the Southeast side of Nawahi
Lane to a pipe;
3. 305° 41' 30" 146.56 feet along government land to an ↗
cut in concrete sidewalk;
4. 36° 43' 114.24 feet along the Northwest side of Ponahawai
Street to the point of beginning.
