Beginning at a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot and the South corner of Mauka Cross Road and Kapehu Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 4713.3 feet South and 3515.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $306^{\circ} 43'$ 1393.6 feet along South side of Mauka Cross Road to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. $355^{\circ} 00'$ 191.6 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
3. $17^{\circ} 46'$ 130.6 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
4. $84^{\circ} 23'$ 195.4 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
5. $35^{\circ} 44'$ 120.0 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
6. $131^{\circ} 15'$ 1493.7 feet along Lot 21 to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. $211^{\circ} 35'$ 61.2 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
8. $236^{\circ} 02'$ 242.9 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
9. $213^{\circ} 00'$ 110.1 feet along East side of Kapehu Road to the point of beginning.
