Beginning at a + on a stone at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 23 and the Eastern boundary of Lot 21, from which the Government Survey Trig. Station "Papapahohola" is by true azimuth and distance $181^{\circ} 01' 4687.3$ feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2378, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 850.1 feet along Lot 23 and the end of the road to a + on stone;
2. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 258.6 feet along Lot 48 to a + on stone at Government Road, thence along road
3. $89^{\circ} 30'$ 106.8 feet to a + on stone;
4. $64^{\circ} 14'$ 150.2 feet to a + on stone;
5. $100^{\circ} 32'$ 239.5 feet to a + on stone;
6. $64^{\circ} 52'$ 130.4 feet to a + on stone;
7. $106^{\circ} 55'$ 184.1 feet to a + on stone;
8. $88^{\circ} 26'$ 79.9 feet to a + on stone at the Southeast corner of Lot 21;
9. $180^{\circ} 00'$ 301.6 feet along Lot 21 to the point of beginning.

Area 6-06/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way for the spill from the reservoir across this lot.
