Beginning at a + on stone at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 21 and on the North side of the Government road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Allen" is  $119^{\circ} 00'$  334.4 feet and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pimoe" are 3406.5 feet North and 572.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2500, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $196^{\circ} 25'$  1150.0 feet along Lot 21 to a + on stone on the South side of the homestead road;
2. Southeasterly along the homestead road to a + on stone, the direct azimuth and distance being  $331^{\circ} 22'$  497.5 feet;
3.  $12^{\circ} 44'$  338.0 feet along Grant 2339 to Kalaola to a + on stone;
4.  $31^{\circ} 29'$  462.0 feet along Grant 2339 to Kalaola to a + on stone on the North side of the Government road;
5. Westerly along the Government road to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $102^{\circ} 57'$  254.0 feet.
