Station "Puu o Kali" being: 1991.0 feet North and 22861.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2516, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 276° 34' 10" 2079.2 feet along Lot 22, Waiohuli-Keokea Beach ^{Hmts} ~~Lots~~;
2. 350° 36' 30" 537.6 feet along Lot 10, Waiohuli-Keokea Grazing Lots;
3. 104° 04' 30" 2161.7 feet along the land of Kamaole;
