Beginning at a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 24, on the West side of Kahawai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalani-ai" being 7288.1 feet North and 2598.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 354° 20' 271.3 feet along West side of Kahawai Road to a 1½ inch pipe;
2. 30° 00' 45.0 feet along same to a 1½ inch pipe;
3. 80° 00' 138.9 feet along same to a 1½ inch pipe;
4. 25° 30' 312.0 feet along same to a 1½ inch pipe;
5. 113° 33' 1148.3 feet along Lot 22 to a 1½ inch pipe;
6. 203° 33' 670.0 feet along East side of the Gravity Railroad right-of-way to a 1½ inch pipe;
7. 293° 33' 1147.3 feet along Lot 24 to the point of beginning.
