Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 23, and on the East side of Kapehu Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 4334.2 feet South and 4041.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 220° 26' 134.4 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
2. 199° 19' 259.2 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
3. 147° 46' 94.8 feet along East side of Kapehu Road;
4. 198° 56' 147.4 feet along East side of Kapehu Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 311° 15' 1287.8 feet along Lot 25 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 349° 35' 85.0 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
7. 335° 51' 155.9 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
8. 58° 14' 123.0 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
9. 30° 00' 255.4 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
10. 107° 12' 128.0 feet along top of West edge of Kapehu gulch;
11. 131° 15' 1147.6 feet along Lot 23 to the point of beginning.
