Beginning at a + on stone at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 23 and on the South side of Government road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Paper" is $114^{\circ} 36' 30''$ 1243.5 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalua-moa" are 6434.5 feet South and 347.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2493, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $15^{\circ} 34'$ 1384.7 feet along Lot 23 across three ditches to a + on stone on the North side of road to Kukuiula;
2. $103^{\circ} 13'$ 303.7 feet along road to Kukuiula to a + on stone;
3. $104^{\circ} 08'$ 8.32 feet along road to Kukuiula to a + on stone;
4. $195^{\circ} 34'$ 1348.7 feet along Lot 25 across three ditches to a + on stone on the South side of Government road
5. $276^{\circ} 38'$ 315.0 feet along South side of Government road to the point of beginning.

Area 9-77/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom rights-of-way 15 feet wide across this lot for the³ditches, said rights-of-way containing an area of 44/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 9-33/100 ACRES.
